

#### 3.1 RESIDENCE PERMIT

All students studying in TRNC are required by law to obtain a residence permit. There are penalties for those who fail to do so, and you may not be permitted to leave the island until you pay the penalty for staying on the island on an illegal status. Please remember that you are required to open a file within one month of your entry to the island. Otherwise you will need to pay the applicable penalty fee.

At the beginning of each academic year, Eastern Mediterranean University invites the immigration officials to the student services office to ease the process of taking the residence permits.

For the first application the following documents are required:

- Student Certificate (taken from Registrar's Office)
- The Residence Permit fee to be announced io.emu.edu.tr
- \*Health Report (Blood tests and Lung X Ray) (The tests must be done in TRNC) fee to be announced io.emu.edu.tr
- The original passport and photocopies of relevant pages (ID page, the page that shows validity, the page that has the entry date seal and a copy of the last residency permit)
- Revenue Stamp (Damga pulu) (Taken from the post office) fee to be announced io.emu.edu.tr
- \*A passport size picture (required in the first time)
- Dormitory record sheet (for those staying at dormitories) or a copy of your contract (for those staying off campus)
- \*For NEWLY registered students only

#### 3.2 DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

For those whose behaviours do not meet student and society's moral values inside or outside the campus, one of the following penalties will be applied by the EMU Student Disciplinary Committee depending on the type of the offence.

- Warning
- Reprimand
- Short-term suspension from the University (1-30 days)
- Medium and long term suspension from the University (31 days-1 semester)
- Dismissal from the University

### **Living in North Cyprus**

Any act of cheating or any behaviour which has an effect on the exam results is believed to be a misdemeanour. Penalty for such a behaviour is short-term suspension from the University. In case of repeated misbehaviour, penalty increases exponentially.

## Grants or scholarships of students who receive a suspension penalty are terminated.

Families are informed about a student's misbehaviour outside the campus. Students found guilty due to the off-campus misbehaviour by the court are referred to EMU Student Disciplinary Committee where they may also be issued a penalty.

## Registration Procedures



#### REGISTRATION PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED

• Registration Help Desk

Welcome to the Turkish Republic North Cyprus (T.R.N.C). Please visit the registration help desk in the Registran's Office.

Required Documents

Prepare your required registration documents (e.g. Passport, Diploma, Transcripts, etc.) and submit them to the help-desk. Fill in the required forms and get your payment size.

Tuition Fee

With your payment slip, go to the nearest bank and pay the tution fee specified on the slip and bring the receipt of payment back to the help desk.

Take Your Folder

From the help desk, take your student folder and go to the Registrar's Office. Take a queue number and submit your loker to the staff member responsible for your.

Wait for Two Hours

After two (2) hours, go back to the same staff member and obtain your Student Certificate.

Sit for the English Exam

If you don't have any internationally recognized English certificate (e.g. ELTS, TOEFL and so forth), you should take the English Proficiency Test.

#### 5.1 STUDENT SERVICES OFFICE

Operating under the Registrar's Office, the Student Services Office works in coordination with other units responsible for life in campus and student related academic and social issues. Moreover, Student Services Office provides the services listed below:

#### 5.2 IMMIGRATION PROCEDURES

Eastern Mediterranean University International Students an opportunity to complete their Immigration Procedures within the campus by bringing officers from District Governor's Office, Hospital and Tax Department together at the beginning of each academic semester.

#### 5.3 CAMPUS CARD

Campus Card is designed by the university in cooperation with KOOP Central Bank in order to make the students' lives easier. The card, indicating that its owner is an EMU student, can also be used both in and out of the campus and provides various opportunities for students.

#### 5.4 TRNC HEALTH INSURANCE PROCEDURES

According to the agreement between TRNC Ministry of Health and Social Aid and Eastern Mediterranean University, EMU students are under the coverage of health insurance. International students who are not citizens of TRNC can obtain their health holograms from Student Services Office.

#### 5.5 CRISIS MANAGEMENT

Crisis Management is a cooperation system established for the students of Eastern Mediterranean University. It helps to bring students' possible health problems, injuries or daily issues under control. All the operations (public security, medical and moral assistance, loss assessment, information sharing between institutions, fast communication and intervention) are controlled by Crisis Management center in time of a crisis.

#### 5.6 DIPLOMA APPROVAL PROCEDURES

Nationals of the Republic of Turkey, Foreign Countries and TRNC who are planning to work/study abroad upon their graduation are required to complete diploma approval procedures.

- · Documents Required for Diploma Approval:
- Diploma Approval Application Form
- Diploma Approval Fee Receipt (Students gratuation from a Turkish-Medium Program are required to pay 375 TL and those graduation from an English
- -Medium Program are expected to pay 390TL)
- Diploma Approval Fee should be deposited to the University account under the title of "Diploma Approval Procedure".

#### 5.7APOSTILLE APPROVAL PROCEDURES

Apostille procedures are required for araduate students who are to study/work in Europe or the United States. Apostille approval are done on behalf of students by the Student Services Office at the Registrars Office. For more information please visit the Student Services Office.

#### **6.1 REGISTRATION**

Students renew their registration at the beginning of every semester. Registrar's Office provides assistance to students and academic personnel in registration renewal. During the first registration, new students must submit original diplomas and transcripts.

#### **6.2 ACADEMIC ADVISING**

The aim of the Student Advisorship at Eastern Mediterranean University is to help students in solving the problems they may encounter primarily in academic areas, to provide quidance, to assist them in their chosen profession, to inform them about the facilities of the University and Faculty/ School, to monitor their academic performance and success, in case of failure, to provide relevant assistance and to help in course selection. Academic advisors are faculty members who are appointed by the relevant Department Heads or Directors and announced on department boards.

#### **6.3 CLASS ATTENDANCE**

Students are responsible for attending the lessons, laboratory hours and workshops, all the exams that take place within the semester and all other projects/applications to fulfil program requirements. A student who fails to attend 20% or more of a course or its applications without any excuse fails the course and receives a Nil Grade (NG).

Nil Grade: The student is accepted as being unsuccessful due to not attending the course.

#### 6.4 GRADE CALCULATION (CGPA - GPA)

A student's academic achievement for each term is expressed numerically by an index referred to as the 'Grade Point Average' - GPA. The GPA is The weighted average of course grades. When calculating the course grade, mid-term exam(s), the final exam, lab/workshop reports and/or exams (if applicable), tests, projects, and/or homework are taken into consideration. The CGPA is the cumulative average of all courses taken during all semesters.

#### 7.1 IDENTIFICATION CARDS (ID CARDS)

An ID card is issued to each undergraduate and araduate student. The card is a debit card and can be used for payment in any shop. An ID card can be asked to be presented in order to enter some event or to attend some activities. Additionally, the card may be credited with units which can be debited for payments.






